Helmet and AAD are mandatory. The reserve repacks cycle in Greece is 180 days. Rigging services will be available at Drop Zone. Personal requirements including NAC License

It is the responsibility of the competitor and registration will be taken as a declaration by the Delegation and competitor that the parachuting equipment to be used, is certified as being airworthy by competent authorities. The Organizer has no responsibility in this regard: the responsibility rests fully with the Delegation and competitor.

14. Rules and Regulations

BAF Competition rules 2025 for each discipline.

Every BAF member Country has the right to participate in all 5 airsports with a National team as for:

Skydive accuracy up to 4 males + 2 females + Juniors;

Paragliding accuracy up to 5 males + 3 females + Juniors;

Hang gliding up to 5 males + Juniors;

Microlights 3 axis up to 5 crew's (pilot + navigator);

Aeromodelling F1N up to 5 seniors + 5 juniors.

15. Weather

Average daytime temperature during September is between $30-32^{\circ}$ C in the morning and 16-18 in the afternoon .

18. Other matters

- 18.1. National flag and anthem each delegation must bring its own national flag and its national anthem in a MP3 format to be used in ceremonies. The recommended flag size is 100cm x 150cm, and depending on a maximum number of potential medalists in one category.
- 18.2. Other Planed Social Events: There are various relevant touristic attractions nearby, that can be reached in a 10 minutes' drive (10 to 20 km)
